Rules & Regulations

1. A \$45 Office Fee will be charged to each account payable with entry fees which will cover EMT fees.
2. There will be a 10-minute schooling break prior to each division in the main ring. No schooling on the Derby Field. Main Ring schooling for Maiden Hunter and Side Ring schooling for Pre-Children's Hunter Pony must be completed prior to the start of the show. All 2'schooling for Main Ring & Side Ring must be completed prior to start of show.

Derby Day Schooling Schedule: unjudged warm up A&B 2', unjudged warm up A&B 2'6", unjudged warm up A&B 3' Side Ring open all day for unpaid schooling.
3. Any horse that is schooling and not entered in a class must register with the Show office and wear a show number in order to school. The fee is \$20.
4. Entry Fees are \$25 per class, \$42 per Marshall & Sterling class, \$15 per Lead Line class, \$50 for the Crossrail Derby, \$75 for the 2' Hunter Derby, \$150 for the 2'6" Hunter Derby, \$200 for the 3' Hunter Derby, and \$20 for Unjudged Warm Up A & Unjudged Warm Up B.
5. The third over fences class of the Children's Hunter Pony, Children's Hunter Horse, and Adult Amateur Hunter divisions will also count as the first round of the Marshall & Sterling Hunter Classics.
6. All signed check or cc on file and completed entry blank must be submitted before back numbers can be issued.
7. A Fee of \$40 will be charged for all non-negotiable checks.
8. Enter online at horseshowing.com. An incomplete entry form cannot be issued a back number. There is no cost to the exhibitor for online entries. A \$15 late fee will be charged if entry is submitted after November 2, a \$30 late fee will be charged if entry is submitted the day of the show, and a \$30 late fee will be charged if you fail to check out. Please send a copy of a current negative coggins.
9. All hunter classes will be judged on performance and soundness with an emphasis on soundness and manners unless otherwise noted.
10. A horse and rider combination may cross-enter into any derby. However, NO HORSE may compete in the same derby ring/field twice.
11. The Gleneayre Horse Show, the Gleneayre Equestrian Program, Gleneayre Farms, Inc., the Committee, or the property owners will not be responsible for any accident, loss or damage which may occur to any horse, rider or equipment before, during or after the show.
12. The Committee reserves the right to cancel, combine, change location or add any class(es) or schooling deemed necessary.
13. Should any question arise, it will be directed to the Show Committee, whose decision shall be final.
14. Jump orders will be constructed at the discretion of the show management.
15. Failure to enter the ring within two minutes of being called will incur elimination.
16. All riders must wear proper attire including ASTM/SEI certified headgear at all times while mounted on the show grounds.
17. All dogs must be leashed.
18. It is a condition of entry to the show grounds that these rules and regulations be read, understood, and accepted.
19. Footing is sand in both rings. Ring sizes are 100' x 200' and 150' x 250'.

The points from the 2023 Gleneayre Horse Show will count towards year-end awards for the 2023 Gleneayre Hunter Series presented by Courses By Design. Championships and Reserves to be awarded in all divisions.

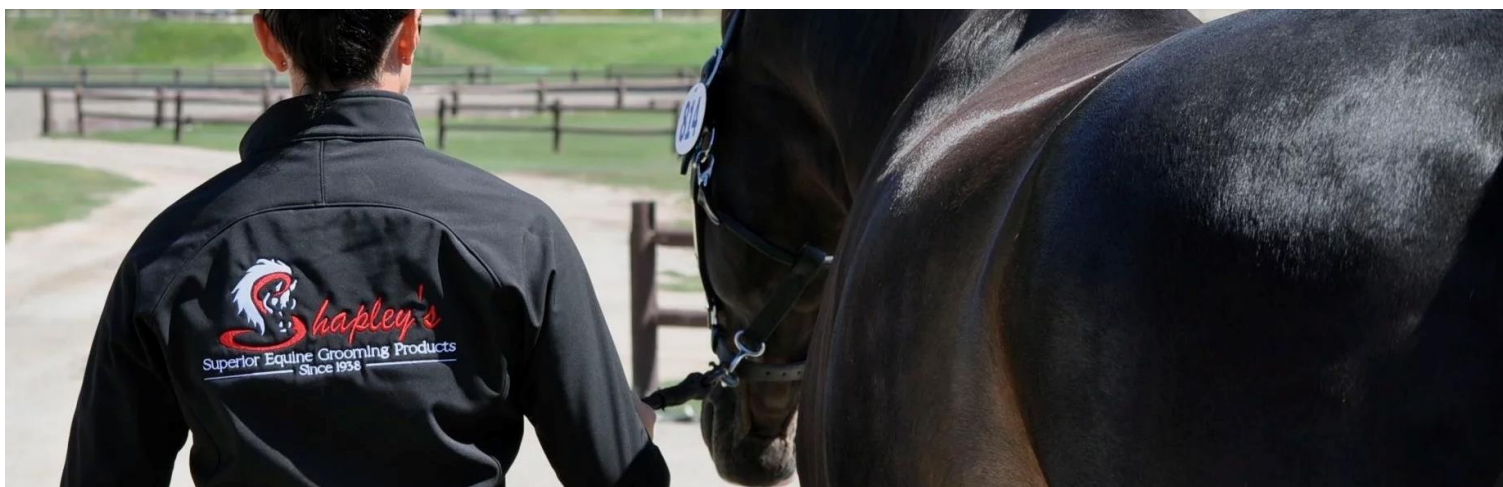

Healey individually, Harm to me or my horse and for claims made by others for any Harm caused by me or my horse, including Harm resulting from the negligence of the Competition and I understand that I am entitled to wear protective equipment without penalty, and I acknowledge that the Competition strongly encourages me to do so while WARNING that no protective equipment can guard against all injuries. If I am a parent or guardian of a junior exhibitor, I consent to the child's participation and AGREE to assume all of the obligations of this Release on the child's behalf. I AGREE that Competition Committee, Gleneayre Farms, Inc., Antonio Spagoli Trust, and Gleneayre Equestrian Program as used above includes all of the officials, officers, directors, employees, agents, personnel, volunteers, and affiliated organizations. Rt. 206 South to Rt. 38 to jug-handle (Eayrestown/Mt, Holly Business District). At stop, make left, cross over Rt. 38 (you are now on Eayrestown Rd.) and continue for approximately 2.5 miles. Pass the front entrance to Gleneayre Farm on your right, then turn right onto Bridge Road. Horse show entrance is 1000 feet on your right.

From Rt. 295

Exit 40 to 38 East (Moorestown-Mt. Holly) for approximately 5 miles and make a right at Masonville/Fostertown Rd. (2nd street from Prospectors Restaurant). Go through blinking light and take road for about 2.5 miles to light. Turn left at light (Main Street – Rt. 541). Turn right at first street (Bridge Rd. – Rt. 612 East). Follow Bridge Road for approximately 1 mile and the horse show entrance is on your left.

From NJ Turnpike

Exit 5 (mt. Holly) to Rt. 541 South. Continue on Rt. 541 South bypass to Lumberton. Bear right on Rt. 541 South at the Burger King. Continue across Rt. 38 and follow to Village of Lumberton turning right at traffic light on Main Street (Rt. 541). Proceed approximately 1.5 miles after traffic light at Landing Street to left hand turn on Bridge Road. Follow Bridge Road for approximately 1 mile and the horse show entrance is on your left.

From Philadelphia and Camden – Ben Franklin Bridge

Rt. 30 in Camden to Rt. 38 East, continue to Lumberton, approximately 20 miles and make a right at traffic light on Masonville/Fostertown Rd. (2nd street from Prospectors Restaurant). Go through blinking light and take road for about 2.5 miles to light. Turn left at light (Main Street – Rt. 541). Turn right at first street (Bridge Rd. – Rt. 612 East). Follow Bridge Road for approximately 1 mile and the horse show entrance is on your left.

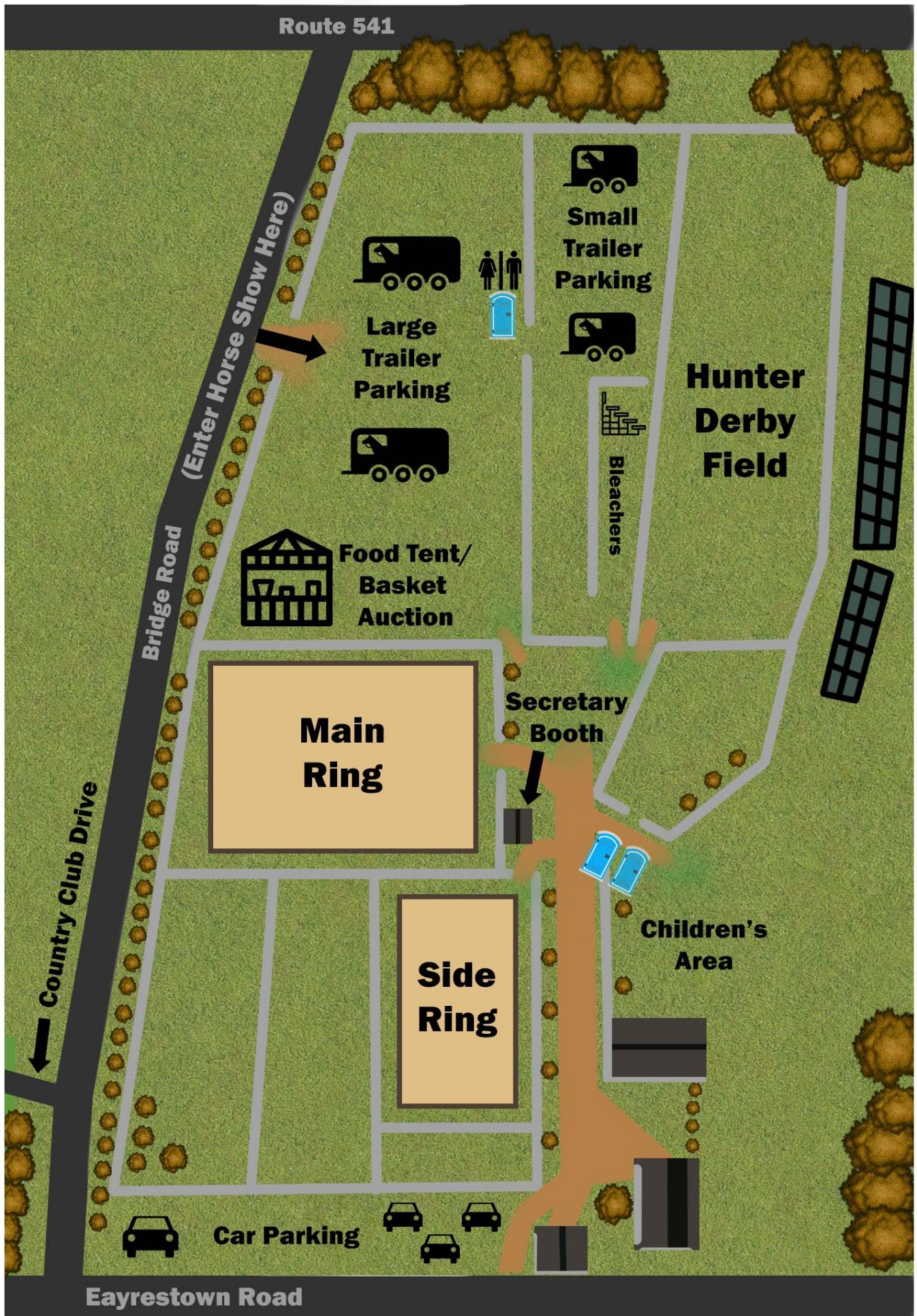

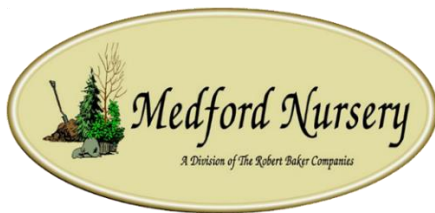

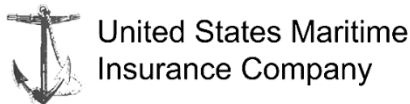
