Rules & Regulations

1. A \$50 Office Fee will be charged to each account payable with entry fees which will also cover EMT fees. This will serve as a deposit and is required to process an entry. This is not refundable or transferable.
2. NO SCHOOLING on Saturday in the Side Ring or Main Ring, HAND WALKING ONLY.
3. NO SCHOOLING on Sunday in the Main Ring, HAND WALKING ONLY.
4. ENTRY FEES: \$30 per class, \$30 for the Walk-Trot Derby, \$30 for the Leadline Derby, \$50 for the Crossrail Derby, \$75 for the 2' Hunter Derby, \$150 for the 2'6" Hunter Derby, \$200 for the 3' Hunter Derby.
5. All signed checks or credit cards on file and completed entry blank must be submitted before back numbers can be issued.
6. A Fee of \$40 will be charged for all non-negotiable checks.
7. Enter online at www.horseshowing.com. An incomplete entry form cannot be issued a back number and will go to the top of the jump order. There is no cost to the exhibitor to process online entries.
8. A \$15 late fee will be charged if entry is submitted after October 31st, a \$30 late fee will be charged if entry is submitted the day of the show. Please bring a copy of a current negative coggins and vaccination report. Failure to close out your entries at the Secretary's Booth will result in a \$30 charge per horse.
9. Check the specifications for each Derby to see cross entry restrictions.
10. The Gleneayre Horse Show, the Gleneayre Equestrian Program, Gleneayre Farms, Inc., the Committee, or the property owners will not be responsible for any accident, loss or damage which may occur to any horse, rider or equipment before, during or after the show.
11. The Committee reserves the right to cancel, combine, change location or add any class(es) or schooling deemed necessary.
12. Should any question arise, it will be directed to the Show Management, whose decision shall be final.
13. The decision of the Judge shall be final.
14. Jump orders for all Derbies will be constructed and posted by show management.
15. Failure to enter the ring within two minutes of being called will incur elimination.
16. All riders must wear proper attire including ASTM/SEI certified headgear at all times while mounted on show grounds.
17. All dogs must be leashed.
18. It is a condition of entry to the show grounds that these rules and regulations be read, understood, and accepted.
19. Footing is a combination of sand and GGT in both rings. Ring sizes: Side Ring: 100' x 200' and Main Ring: 150' x 250'.
20. Entries, counts, and results will be posted on www.horseshowing.com.

Horse Show and Hunter Derby Specifications

1. Leadline Equitation Class – Walk/Trot. Open to all riders 6 and under. Entry Fee: \$30.

2. Gleneayre Leadline Derby

Open to all riders 6 years of age and under. A one-round Derby, always "on lead". Course may include walking over a rail, walking over a rail in a 2-point jumping position, halt, perform a short trot, walk on a loose rein, walk through a pathway, and/or show a handy track at the walk. Rider may not cross enter into any other Derby. Pinning 1st-12th. Entry Fee: \$30.

Walk-Trot Beginner Rider Division – Open to all beginner riders of any age who have not cantered in a horse show. Entry Fee: \$30 per class. Champion and Reserve to be awarded.

3. Walk-Trot Equitation

4. Walk-Trot Pleasure – judged on the horse or pony's manners, suitability and performance

5. Walk-Trot Equitation Over Poles – four cavaletti on the track

6. Gleneayre Walk-Trot Derby

A one-round Derby open to riders of any age who have not cantered in a horse show. Course to be cavaletti poles, may include walking through a pathway, showing a handy track, halting, or walking on a loose rein. Trotting on course not to be penalized. Rider may not cross enter into any other Derby. Pinning 1st-12th. Entry Fee: \$30.

Crossrail Hunter Division – Open to all. Simple changes of lead not penalized. Entry Fee: \$30 per class. Champion and reserve awarded.

Gleneayre 2' Hunter Division – Open to horses and ponies. Fences 2' in height. Entry Fee \$30 per class. Champion and reserve awarded.

Horse/rider combination may not cross enter into any other Derby. Ribbons and \$1,000. prize money to be distributed to the top twelve riders. Entry fee \$75.

Gleneayre Pleasure Division – Open to all in English tack. To be judged on manners, suitability and performance. Entry Fee: \$30 per class. Champion and Reserve awarded.

24. \$5,000 GOSHEN HILL 2'6" HUNTER DERBY – To be shown in the Main Ring.

- Open to all, may be ridden by a Professional, Junior or Amateur. Horse/rider combination may not cross enter into any other Derby.
- ENTRY FEE: \$150
- Cooler for the winner, ribbons and \$5,000 prize money distributed to the top twelve horses.
- \$500 Junior/Amateur Bonus sponsored by Summerhouse. To be awarded to the top four scoring horses ridden by a Junior or an Adult Amateur.
- Fences not to exceed 2'6", with option fences to 2'9".

FIRST ROUND: The first round shall be judged on performance, hunter pace, jumping style, quality and substance, and movement. After the judge(s)' base score is given, one (1) point will be added for each high option fence jumped. The Option Bonus Score of one additional point must be awarded even if there is a refusal, rail down or loss of good jumping style at that higher height option fence, providing that the horse does jump the higher height option fence. The top twelve horses will be invited to return for the second round in reverse order of scores.

SECOND ROUND: The second round shall be judged on performance, hunter pace, jumping style, quality and substance, movement, brilliance and handiness. Handiness is defined as ground saving movement without adversely affecting performance or style. Handiness and brilliance are taken into account in the judges' base score. After the judge(s)' base score is given, one (1) point will be added for each high option fence jumped. The Option Bonus Score of one additional point must be awarded even if there is a refusal, rail down or loss of good jumping style at that higher height option fence, providing that the horse does jump the higher height option fence. The total scores from each round will be added together to obtain the final score for each horse.

25. \$7,500 ARTHUR H. THOMAS 3' HUNTER DERBY – To be shown in the Main Ring.

- Open to all, may be ridden by a Professional, Junior or Amateur. Horse/rider combination may not cross enter into any other Derby.
- ENTRY FEE: \$200
- Cooler for the winner, ribbons and \$7,500 prize money distributed to the top twelve horses.
- \$1,000 Junior/Amateur Bonus sponsored by Summerhouse. To be awarded to the top four scoring horses ridden by a Junior or an Adult Amateur.
- Fences not to exceed 3', with option fences to 3'3".

FIRST ROUND: The first round shall be judged on performance, hunter pace, jumping style, quality and substance, and movement. After the judge(s)' base score is given, one (1) point will be added for each high option fence jumped. The Option Bonus Score of one additional point must be awarded even if there is a refusal, rail down or loss of good jumping style at that higher height option fence, providing that the horse does jump the higher height option fence. The top twelve horses will be invited to return for the second round in reverse order of scores.

SECOND ROUND: The second round shall be judged on performance, hunter pace, jumping style, quality and substance, movement, brilliance and handiness. Handiness is defined as ground saving movement without adversely affecting performance or style. Handiness and brilliance are taken into account in the judges' base score. After the judge(s)' base score is given, one (1) point will be added for each high option fence jumped. \$1,000 Busiest Trainer Award: Awarded both Saturday and Sunday.

Awarded to the person who is declared as trainer on the most pre-entered horses that compete on that show day and does indeed train those horses at the show. One winner will be chosen on Saturday, and another winner will be chosen on Sunday.

I am fully aware and acknowledge that horse sports and the Competition involve inherent dangerous risks of accident, loss and serious bodily injury including broken bones, head injuries, trauma, pain, suffering, or death ("Harm"). I AGREE to release the Competition, Gleneayre Equestrian Program, the Competition Committee, Gleneayre Farms, Inc., Antonio Spagoli Trust, and Ellen J. Healey individually. I AGREE to expressly assume all risks of Harm to me or my horse, including Harm resulting from the negligence of the Competition or the above named persons individually, and to hold them harmless with the respect to claims for Harm to me or my horse and for claims made by others for my Harm caused by me or my horse at the Competition. I have read the Competition Rules about protective equipment and I understand that I am entitled to wear protective equipment without penalty, and I acknowledge that the Competition strongly encourages me to do so while WARNING that no protective equipment can guard against all injuries. If I am a parent or guardian of a junior exhibitor, I consent to the child's participation and AGREE to assume all of the obligations of this Release on the child's behalf. Gleneayre Farm, Inc. Horse Show Committee, and officials, make no representation or warranty, express or implied, about any protective equestrian helmet, and cautions riders that death or serious injury may result despite wearing such equestrian helmet as all equestrian sports involve inherent dangerous risk and no helmet can protect against all foreseeable injuries. For our youth riders under 18 years of age, it is the responsibility of the parent or the guardian to see to it that the equestrian helmet worn complies with appropriate safety standards for protective headgear intended for equestrian use and is properly fitted and in good condition. Riders over age 18 are responsible for their equestrian helmet complying with the standards. Gleneayre Farm, Inc., and/or Show Committee, and officials are not responsible for checking equestrian helmet for such compliance. Driving Directions

Gleneayre Farm - 573 Eayrestown Road, Lumberton NJ, 08048

From Rt.537 West

Rt. 206 South to Rt. 38 to jug-handle (Eayrestown/Mt. Holly Business District). At stop, make left, cross over Rt. 38 (you are now on Eayrestown Rd.) and continue for approximately 2.5 miles. Pass the front entrance to Gleneayre Farm on your right, then turn right onto Bridge Road. Horse show entrance is 1000 feet on your right.

From Rt. 295

Exit 40 to 38 East (Moorestown-Mt. Holly) for approximately 5 miles and make a right at Masonville/Fostertown Rd. (2nd street from Prospectors Restaurant). Go through blinking light and take road for about 2.5 miles to light. Turn left at light (Main Street – Rt. 541). Turn right at first street (Bridge Rd. – Rt. 612 East). Follow Bridge Road for approximately 1 mile and the horse show entrance is on your left.

From NJ Turnpike

Exit 5 (Mt. Holly) to Rt. 541 South. Continue on Rt. 541 South bypass to Lumberton. Bear right on Rt. 541 South at the Burger King. Continue across Rt. 38 and follow to Village of Lumberton turning right at traffic light on Main Street (Rt. 541). Proceed approximately 1.5 miles after traffic light at Landing Street to left hand turn on Bridge Road. Follow Bridge Road for approximately 1 mile and the horse show entrance is on your left.

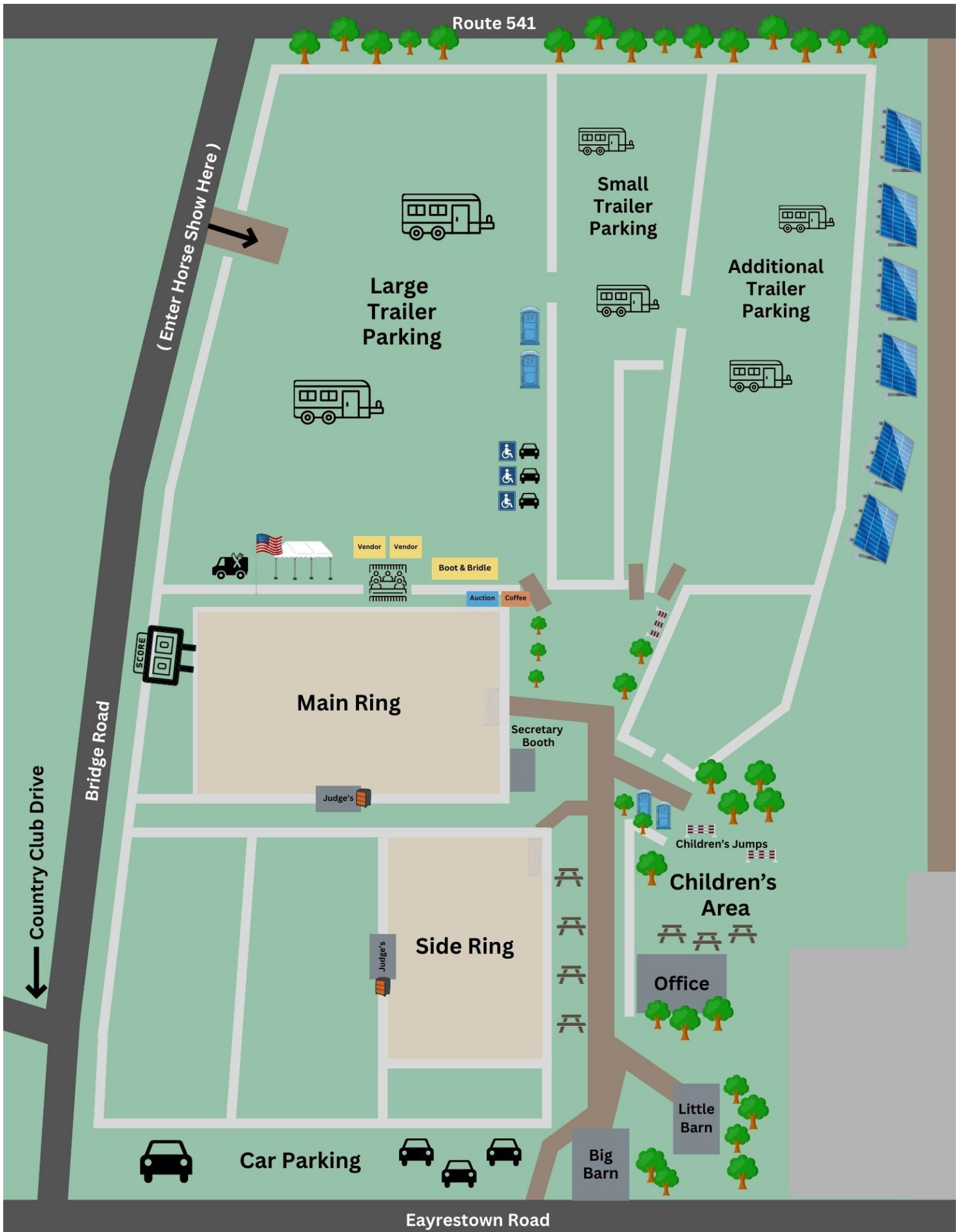
From Philadelphia and Camden – Ben Franklin Bridge

Rt. 30 in Camden to Rt. 38 East, continue to Lumberton, approximately 20 miles and make a right at traffic light on Masonville/Fostertown Rd. (2nd street from Prospectors Restaurant). Go through blinking light and take road for about 2.5 miles to light. Turn left at light (Main Street – Rt. 541). Turn right at first street (Bridge Rd. – Rt. 612 East). Follow Bridge Road for approximately 1 mile and the horse show entrance is on your left.



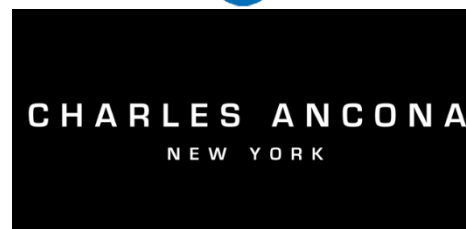
